Conservation Values

- Maintain local work group involvement
- Provide full funding of NRCS programs
- Create regulatory certainty for agricultural producers
- Connect crop insurance payments with conservation compliance
- Provide multi-year certainty that allows producers to commit to long-term investments
- Increase funding for Conservation Technical Assistance (CTA)
- Maintain EQIP and CSP funding levels
- Provide funding to build ponds that support wildlife habitats and provide water for agricultural irrigation
- Fund the Watershed Rehab Program
- Encourage ARS research on water-saving practices
- Support expanded conservation education

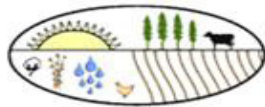

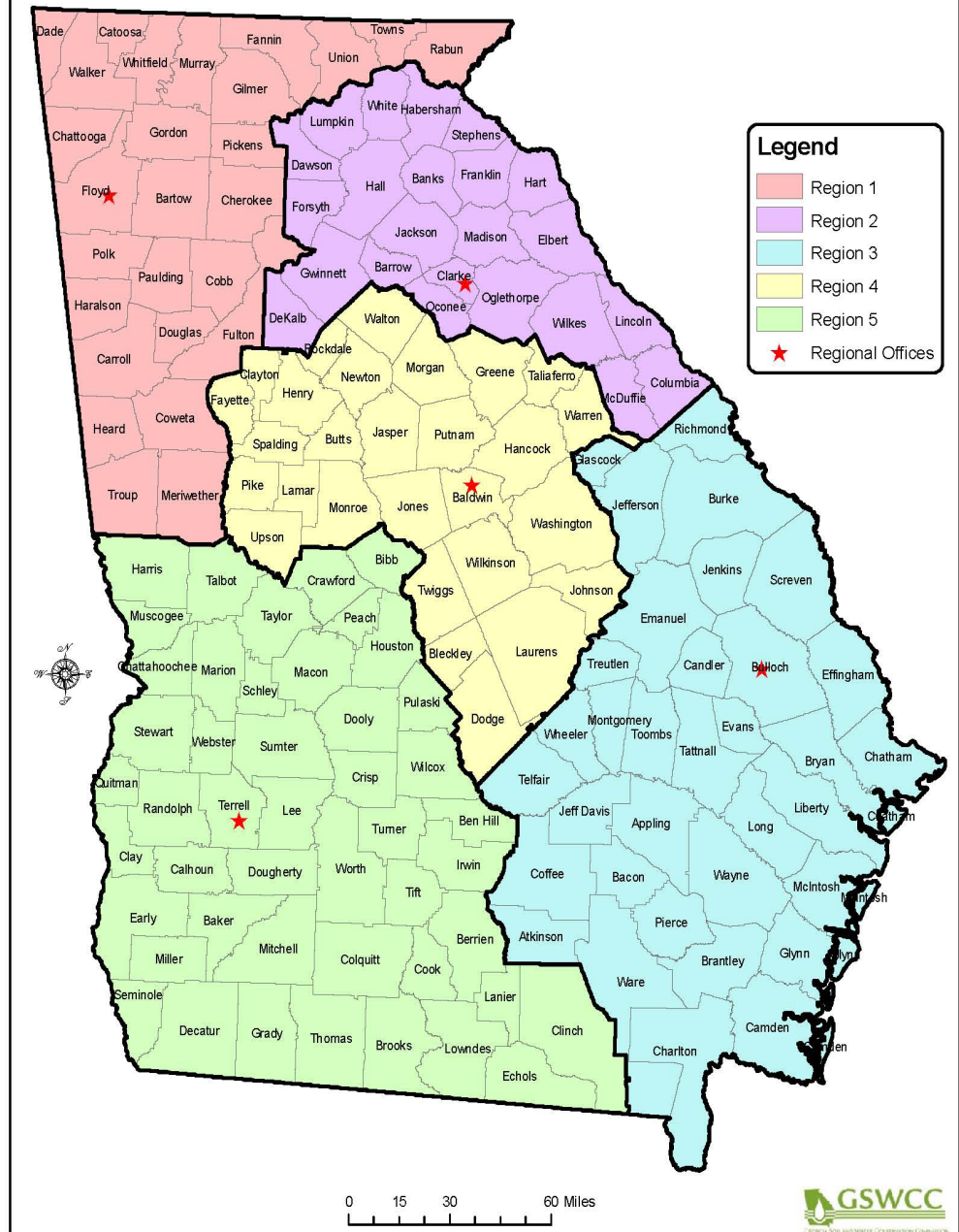
