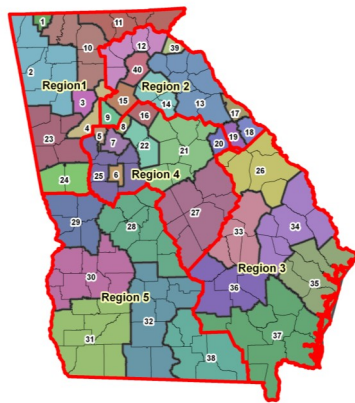


Georgia's Soil and Water Conservation Districts



Soil and Water Conservation Districts provide a way for citizens to set local resource priorities for state and federal assistance and work with cooperating landowners and operators to help them manage and protect land and water resources.

How Do I Get Involved?

Georgia has 40 soil and water conservation districts led by 370 district supervisors. Supervisors are either appointed to a two-year term or elected for terms of four years.
