Notice is hereby given that on November 2, 2010, nonpartisan elections will be held to elect Soil & Water Conservation District Supervisors in 106 counties in Georgia. Please refer to "General Election 2010" for the list of incumbents and expiration dates in the applicable counties. District Supervisors serve as unpaid state officials who represent their counties in support of soil and water conservation activities.

From now until July 2nd, nominations for candidates for the elections will be accepted. The signatures of at least 25 qualified electors of the county are required to nominate a candidate. Nominating petitions must be received in the office of the Elections Superintendent no later than 12:00 noon on July 2, 2010.
