The District offers support to Local Issuing Authorities for their Erosion and Sedimentation programs through education programs and overviews. The District Supervisors also encouraged teams to enter the Envirothon. District support for EQIP, WHIP, CSP, CCRP, and other USDA programs continued. Supervisors continue their support for education of youth in their District by providing Soil and Water Stewardship materials to schools and education centers and they also support the Historic Tree Program. The District seeks grants to use for education at the Marvin H. Jones Memorial Outdoor Learning Center which houses the District's annual Youth Wildlife Field Day in October. The Supervisors support the Two Rivers RC&D council and its programs including the no-till drill program.
