

Little River—Phase 2 Water Quality Improvement Project

PROGRAM SUMMARY:

- An incentive payment, in the form of financial cost-share assistance, will be made to area producers that encourages the incorporation and usage of certain Agricultural Best Management Practices (BMPs) within existing livestock operations to assist in the reduction of fecal pollution within the Little River watershed.
- Program participants will be reimbursed for 50% of the costs of BMP installation based on the current NRCS EQIP practice cost list.
- Applications will be accepted until September 30, 2018.
- Selection notifications will be made by October 15, 2018
- Upon issuance of a contract, participants have six (6) months to commence work and a total of twelve (12) months to complete the contracted project. Failure of a participant to begin work within the first six (6) months will result in contract cancellation.
- Eligible Practices include fencing for rotational grazing and/or exclusion proposes, critical area planting, pasture and hayland planting, heavy use area protection, stream crossings, manure storage, manure transfer, composting facility, nutrient management, water wells, pipeline, etc.

ELIGIBILITY:

- Must have an existing livestock operation physically located in the Little River Watershed that is operational at the time of application.
- All practices must be installed within the Little River Watershed.
- Must install practices in accordance with the Natural Resource Conservation Service's standards and specifications.
- Operation subject to NPDES permitting shall only be eligible for practices not currently required under active permit.
